Meeting Notes

Item	Discussion
1	Apologies for absence
	Apologies were received from KB and SA, ACr also sent apologies and JS attended to represent EGPC in her place.
2	Minutes of the previous meeting (13 March 2014)
	The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and agreed.
3	Matters arising
	JW reported that if the community wished to infill any hedges they felt needed infilling, SSE would have no objection to this. SSE also has no objection to the proposed footpath extension that is being proposed from the road near Grimston to the woodland area. JW has produced some 'postcard' updates for the village notice boards and has posted some laminated ones to SM and MR for their village notice boards. SM to get back to JW with contact details for the member of the public that wishes to speak with SSE regarding church land. All other actions were completed as requested.
4	Aldbrough Operations

	<p>MGi updated that normal operation continues. The first outage of the year took place in May and was completed safely and on time. The next outage will begin one week later than expected on 9 June and is expected to last for 26 days. The 24 hour working has been delayed due to supply chain difficulties and there is no start date yet, we will inform the CLG once this is confirmed. The noise table data for the quarter was circulated. No noise complaints had been received at the time of the meeting, but four incidents were given during the meeting. Post-meeting note: The noise concerns provided at the meeting have been reviewed and feedback has been provided to the member of the public.</p>		
5	Planning conditions		
	Nothing to update with regards to planning conditions for the site.		
6	Feedback from Community Liaison Officer		
	<p>JW and MGi fed back that the site had received information from the Police that Hare Coursers arrested in the area in November 2013 had been prosecuted, and the site had supported the prosecution by providing CCTV evidence. JW reported that Heritage Hedging was continuing to provide monthly updates of work being undertaken at the woodland, and that signage was now in place (see photos below). JH asked if the community could do some planting of their own in and around the wetland to help it to mature more quickly, which SSE agreed to. JW reported that a local fisherman had recently contacted site with some concerns regarding some material that he has found in the fishing nets, SSE are in communication with him.</p>		
7	Community Concerns		
	<p>Prior to the meeting, a member of the CLG had reported lorries travelling through villages that they shouldn't be and asking villagers for directions to the site. JW explained that drivers are given maps and directions for the approved route as part of site contracts, and apologised if drivers had not been using these. JW asked for time and dates of future incidents to be reported to her, so that the drivers responsible could be identified. MGi raised a concern that had been brought up at an internal meeting, regarding youths doing donuts on the site track which by passes Aldbrough village, MR confirmed that this does happen occasionally, but had not been a recent problem. Post meeting note: In aid of Sport Relief, Gas Storage has raised an impressive £666.45 which will now be matched by SSE to make a total contribution of £1332.90 for the charity.</p>		
8	Any other business		
	<p>SM provided some feedback on the signs that have now been put up at the wetland, including an error with regards to the size of the woodland, the name and the language used, JW to feed these back to Heritage Hedging. JH also wished to comment that the woodland and wetland are beginning to establish themselves and are being used and enjoyed by the local community.</p>
