Meeting Notes

Item	Discussion
1	Apologies for absence Apologies were received from MR, SA and PT.
2	Minutes of the previous meeting (28 August 2014) The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and agreed.
3	Matters arising Ditch clearance at the back of properties has been done, and a donation had been given to the defibrillator fund, which SM updated had been very successful and the three villages had been able to purchase three defibrillators, one for each village. JW has posted a laminated postcard to MR, SM had already received his. SSE is to continue to investigate why the hedge that SSE planted between Garton and Grimston has been mown.
4	Aldbrough Operations MGi confirmed that routine operations were continuing. The 24 hour working will begin on 1 December; the first week will be normal working hours, followed by a second week of 24/7 working, and then a return to normal working hours in the run up to Christmas. There may be some impact with regards to

lighting, as the work area will need to be lit up and as its winter, the mornings and evenings are dark. Similar work will be happening again in February/ March time, but this will be confirmed nearer the time. The noise table was distributed; there had been some breaches but no noise complaints this quarter. SM asked why the activities on site had stopped being inputted, but JW clarified that we did this when a compliant had been made. MGi updated that an update from Heritage Hedging with regard to the woodland had been distributed in September, and would be done quarterly going forward. SM said that in the update it said that costs would be provided to SSE and enquired whether these had been provided yet, and when these would be being erected in the woodland as winds can be higher during the winter months, JW to enquire.

5 Planning conditions

Nothing to update with regards to planning conditions for the site.

6 Feedback from Community Liaison Officer

JW updated that SR had gone on maternity leave, and Matthew Sunman is covering her case load whilst she is away, JW continues to send the minutes to ERYC for their information.

7 Community Concerns

SM asked if any work on phase 2 had begun as there had been rumours that it had, MGi confirmed that plans were still on hold. SM asked if Rathlin Energy, who are carrying out seismic surveys to look for gas in the area, had approached SSE/ MGi said that the only conversations SSE had had with Rathlin Energy had been a few years ago when they had come onto the site to do some survey work, but no conversations had taken place since. SM said that the meeting regarding the footpath which will join the existing path, and allow people to enter the woodland, had been constructive. SM asked if the community could gain access to SSE land and the woodland themselves, which MGi confirmed would be okay.
