1	Apologies for absence Apologies were received for Janice Harvey
2	Minutes of the previous meeting (14 th April 2016) The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and agreed.
3	Matters Arising MG informed the group that there had been some viewings at Church Farm, the property remains on the market. BJH noted that some trees on the woodland were doing well.
4	Aldbrough Operations MG informed the group that the recent site outage had been completed on safely and on time. MG noted that there was nothing to show on the noise table.

5	Battery Storage Project Update		
	<p>The project is still progressing. A tender was submitted to National Grid last week for a contract. Decision is expected later in the summer. Once confirmed further information will be shared with the community. This communication is likely to be via newsletter to surrounding villages.</p> <p>**Additional note**</p> <p><u>Following the meeting SSE received confirmation from EYRC that the proposed battery storage project can be progressed under permitted development of the site.</u></p>		
6	Planning conditions		
	<p>MG informed the group that planning consent for phase 2 of the development will lapse on 26/09/16. SSE met with ERYC and would like to share the following statement</p> <p><i>“SSE and Statoil (UK) Ltd have consent to increase the storage capacity at the Aldbrough site. The project, known as Aldbrough Phase 2, has not been progressed due to current market conditions. The planning consent expires on 26 September 2016 and there are no plans to extend this existing consent.”</i></p> <p>MG added that in addition to the above there are three issues to finalise with ERYC</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Phase two bunding was installed in advance of the construction of the project, it is proposed that this bunding remains 2. Gate access for phase 2 – this gate is to remain in place 3. The agreed S106 will not commence given that planning has lapsed. Part of the S106 agreement was the community woodland which was planted in advance. This woodland is to remain in place. Under the agreement the woodland would have been transferred to ERYC, however, SSE will continue to maintain it by SSE. <p>MR asked if phase 2 land could still be used – MG informed the group that there are currently no plans for this land to be used.</p>
