The council has also been able to support the Aldbrough Village Foodbank.

The community bus has continued to run throughout the lockdown thanks to funding from East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

Two CCTV cameras have been purchased with funding from Withernwick Wind Farm, thanks given to Cllr Hammond for putting them up and getting them going and to the village hall for allowing us to put them there.

Installation of phase one of the playpark is now complete and has received positive feedback and has seen an increase in use.

The Parish Council continues to highlight speeding, however, are extremely disappointed that the yellow lines promised two years ago for Carlton Lane have still to be done.

We will continue to work in the coming year for the residents and village environment.
